7 sectors that have 4 or more honorees - 31%

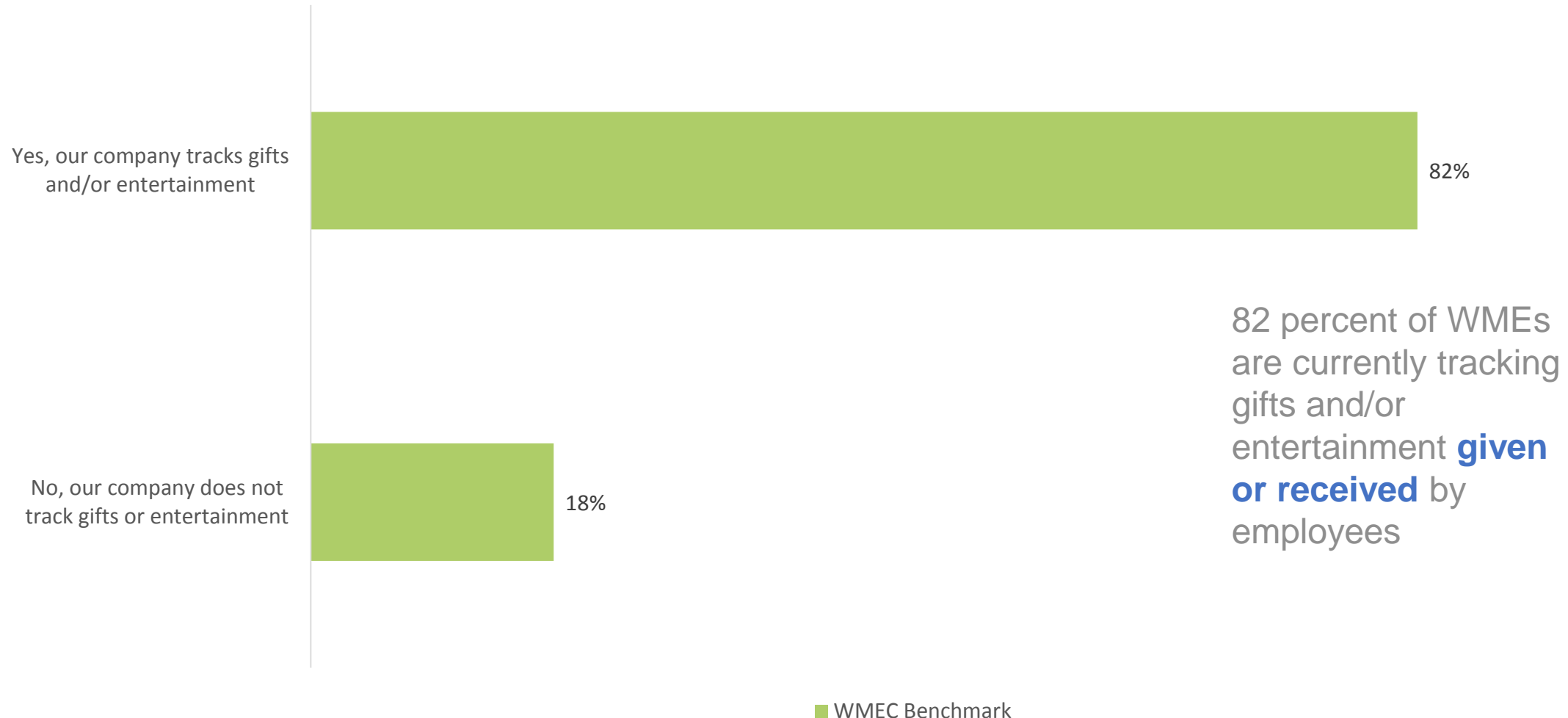


Annual Revenue (US\$) (Privately Held Companies where available)



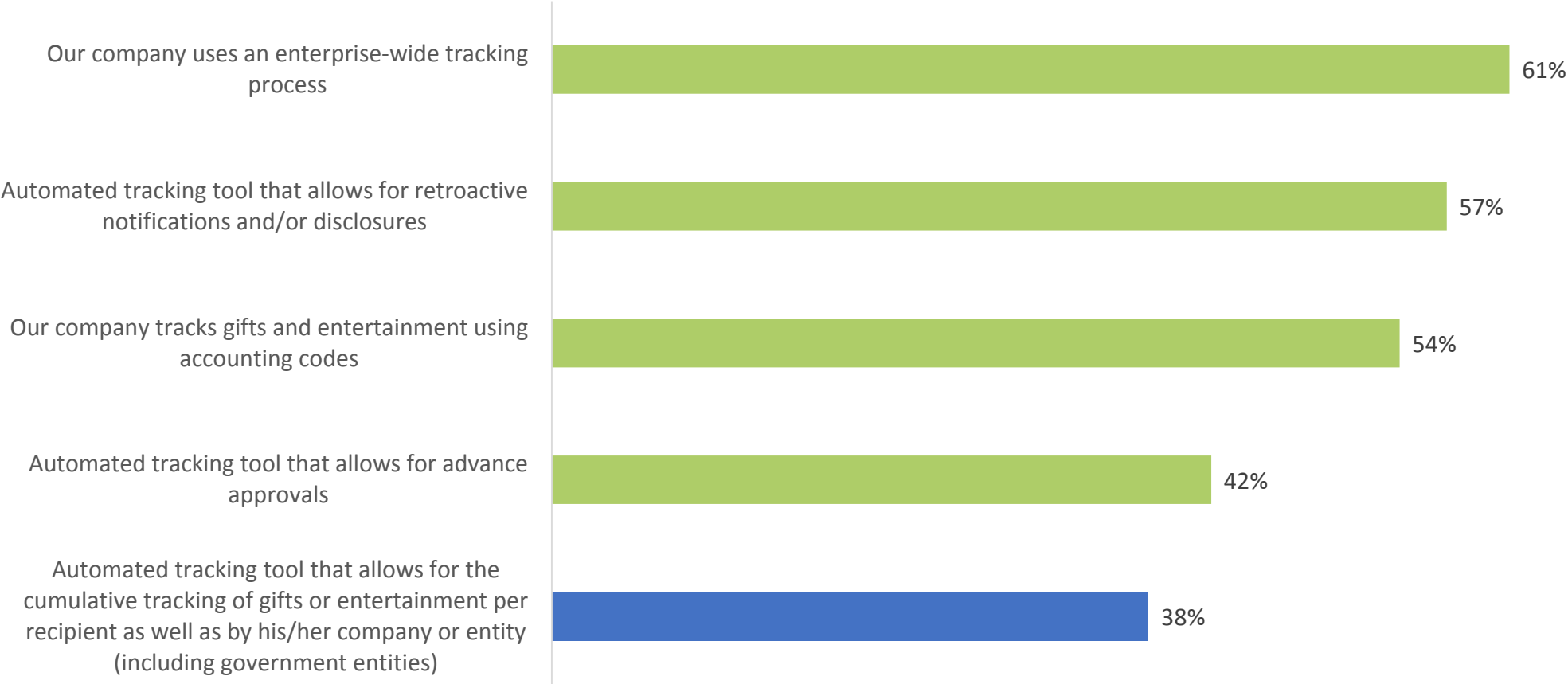

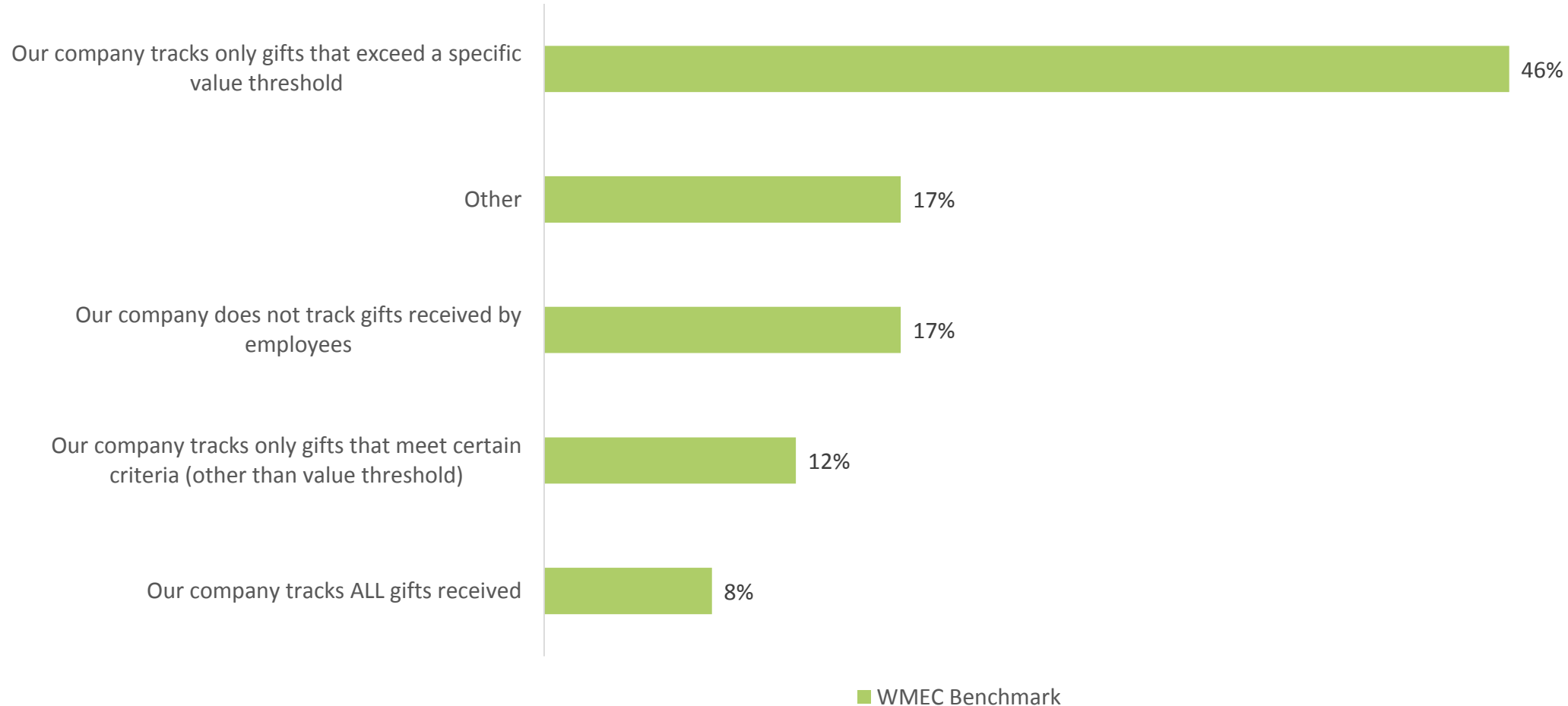
Which of the following that describes the process or tool used to track entertainment and/or gifts given or received by your company’s employees.

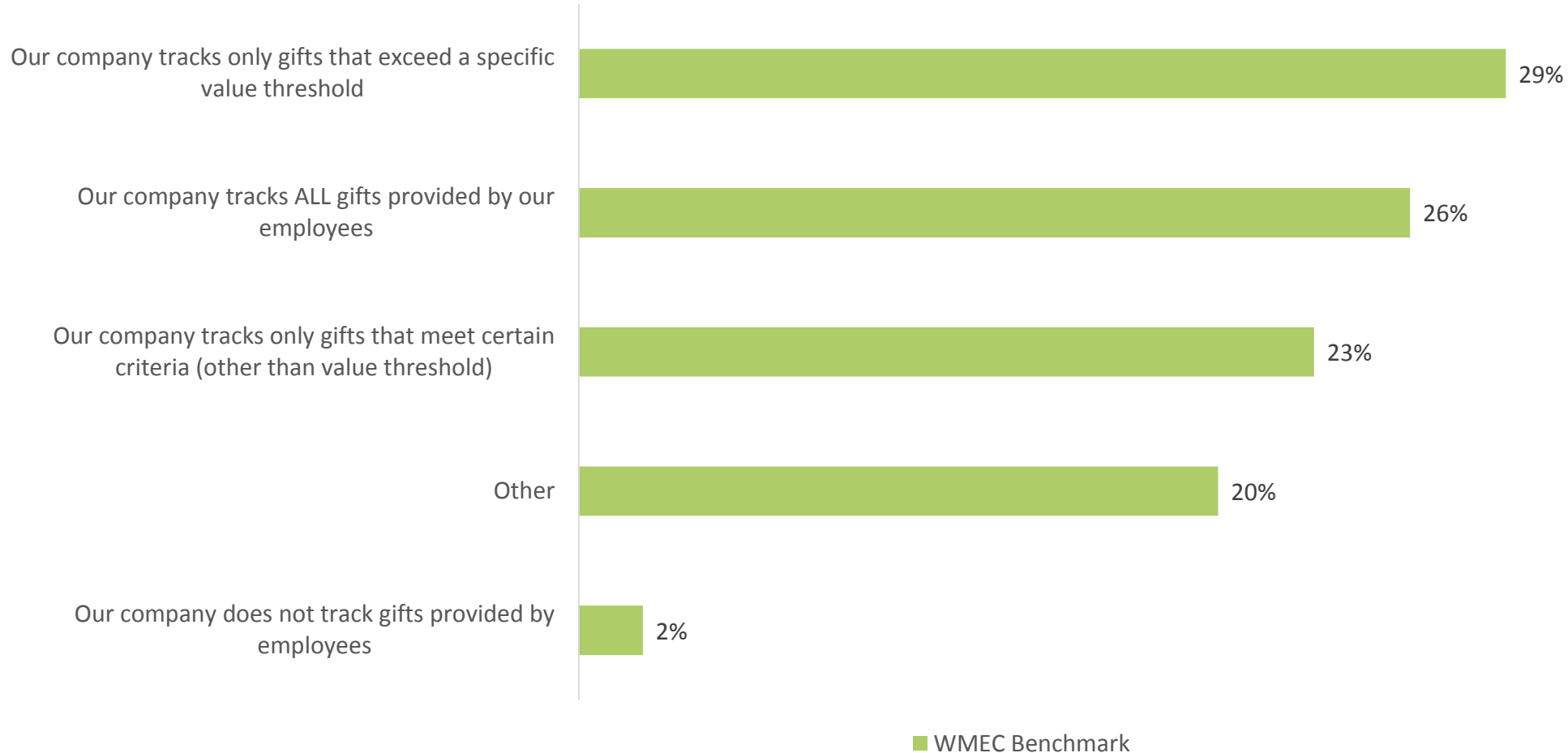

To what extent does your company track gifts **received** by your employees?



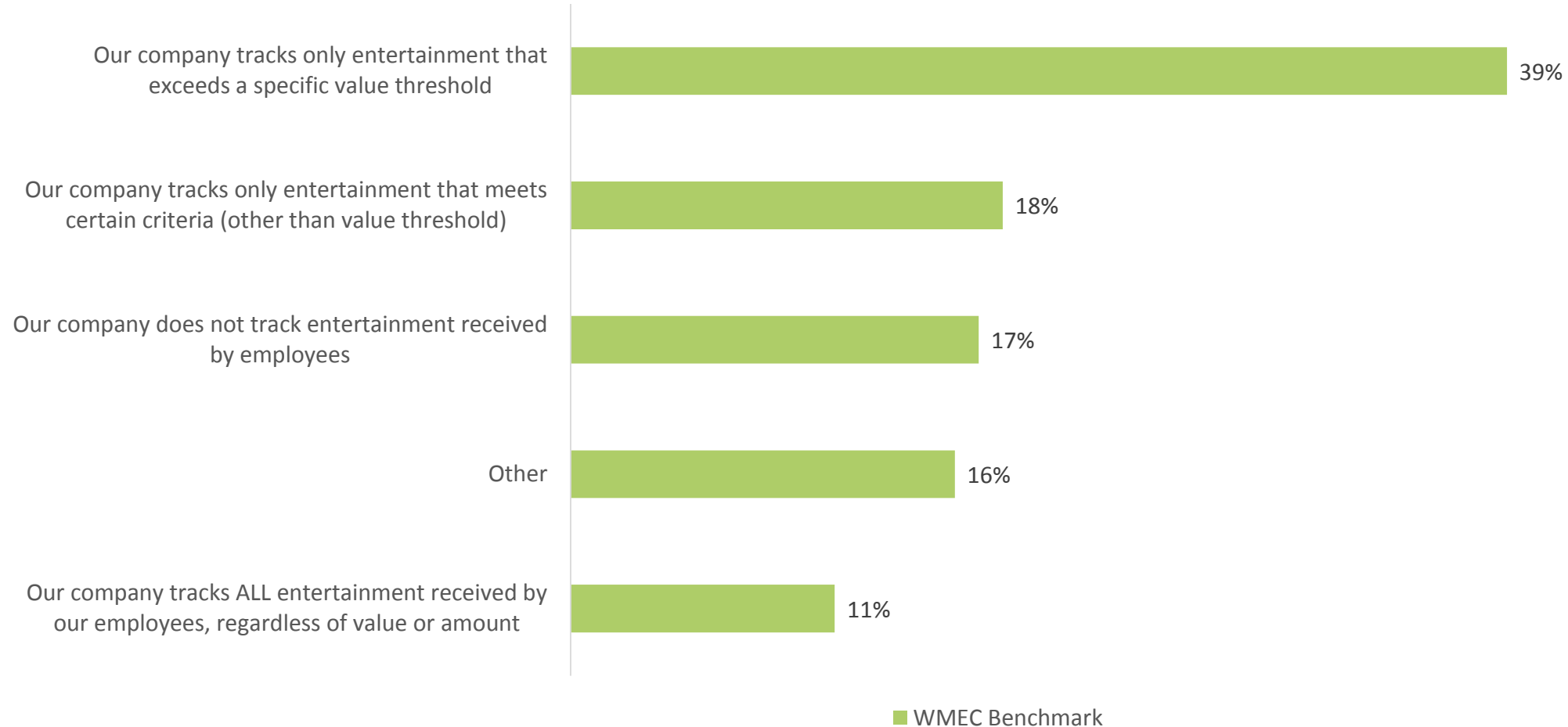

To what extent does your company track gifts **provided** by your employees?



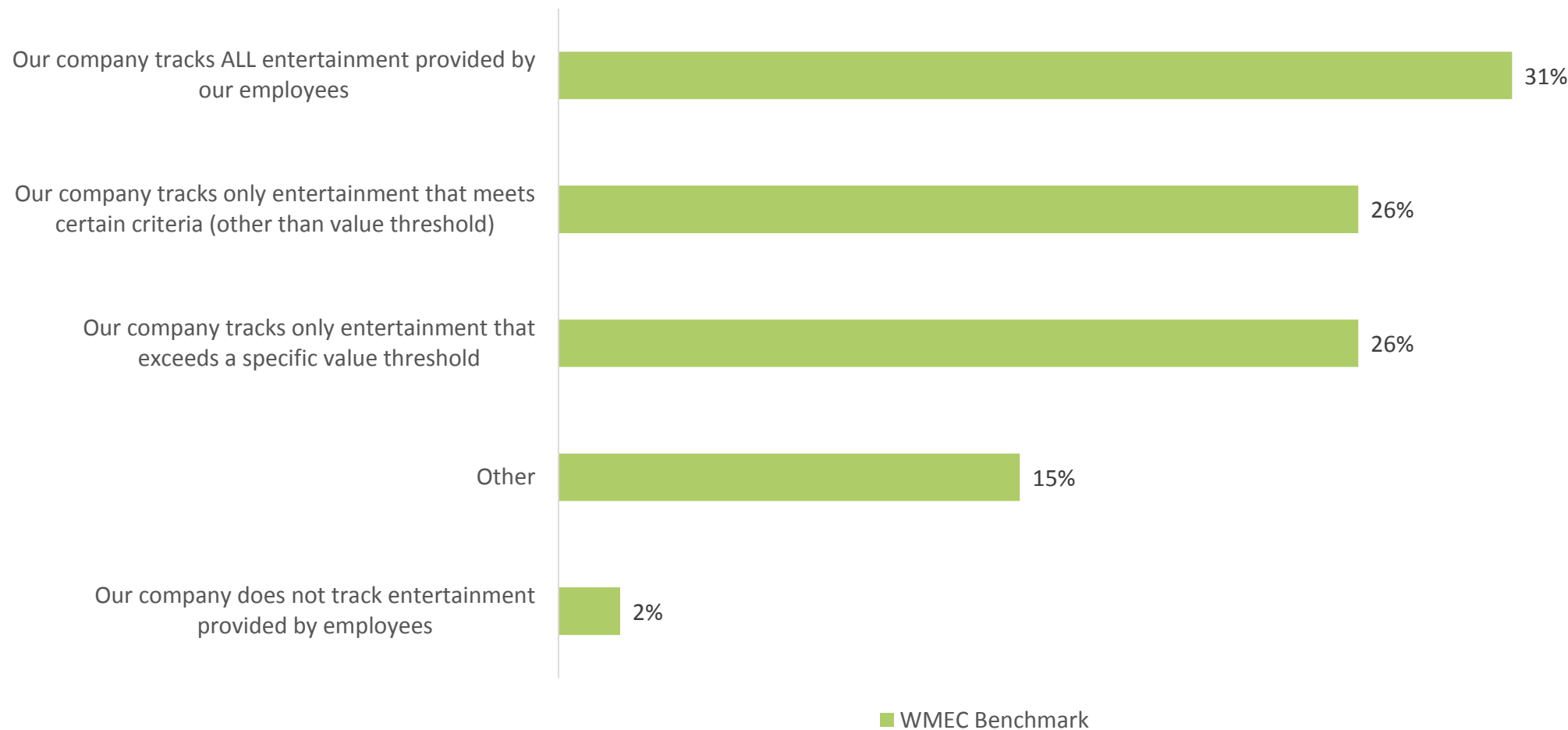
