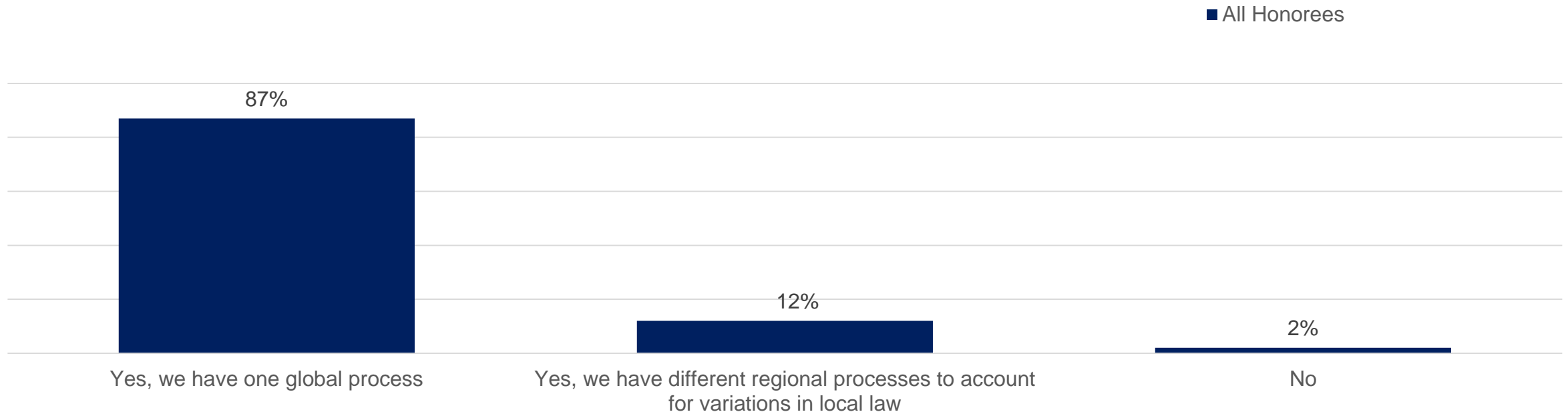
World's Most Ethical Companies as Benchmark Data Set

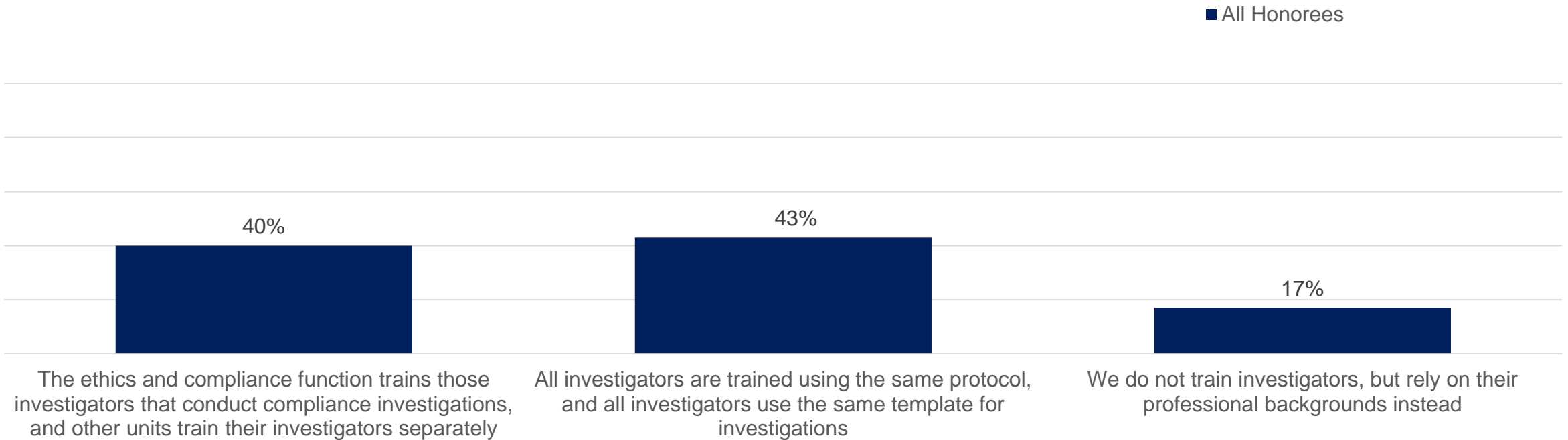

EQ 4F.1 Does your company have a written misconduct investigation process?



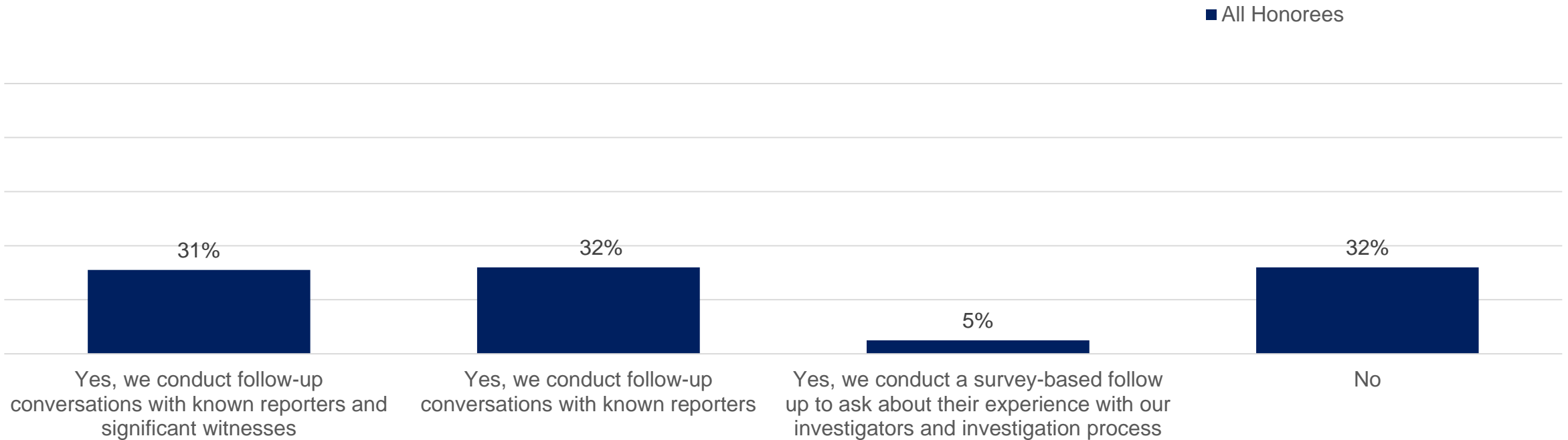

EQ 4F.2 How is your organization training investigators?



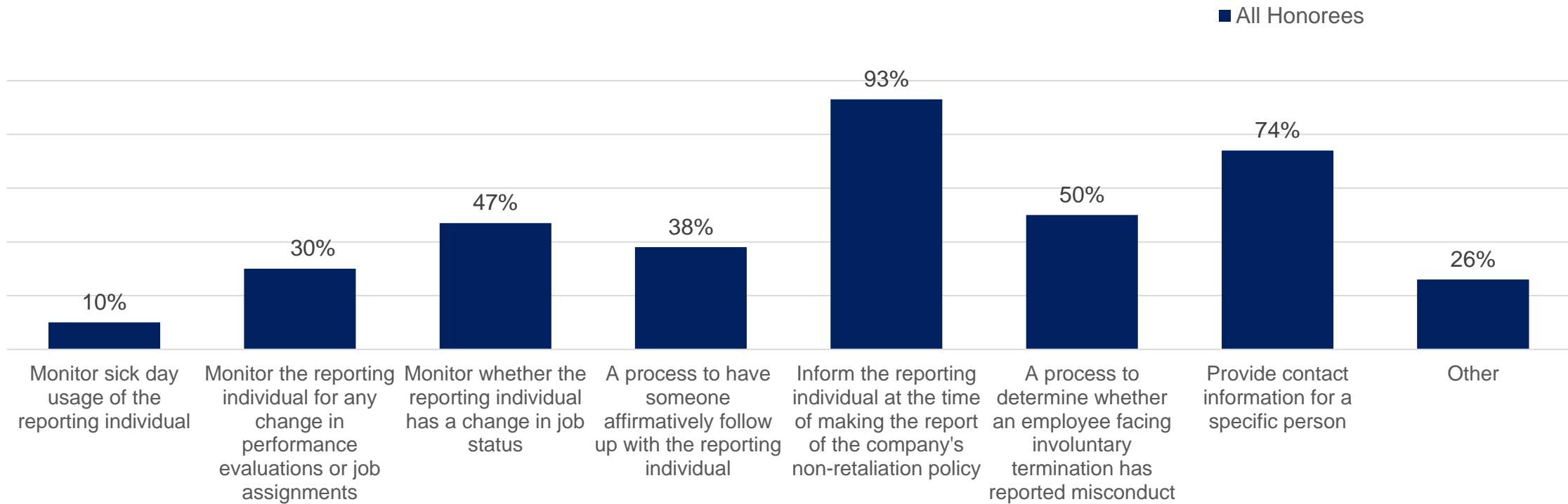
