World's Most Ethical Companies as Benchmark Data Set

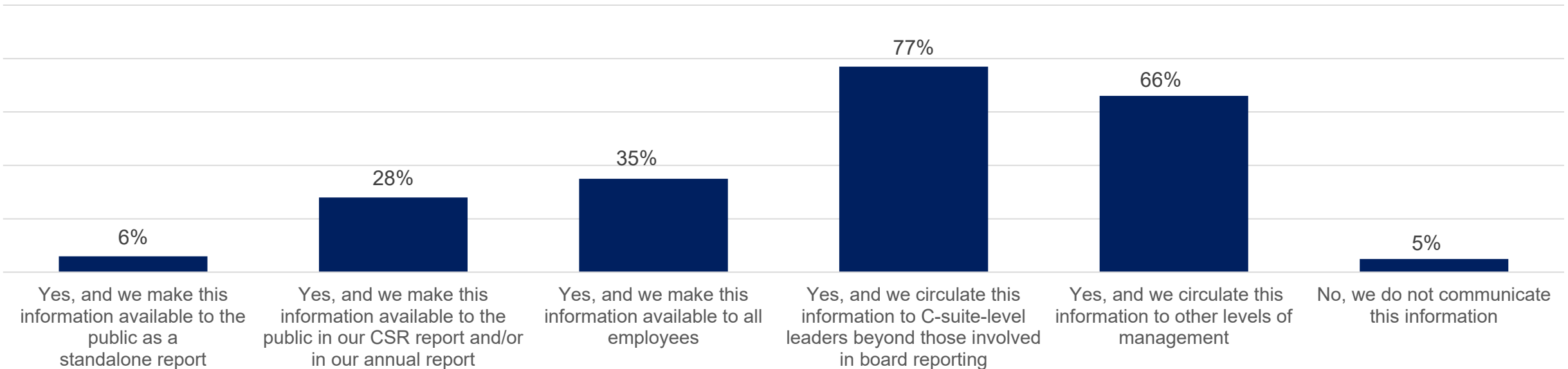

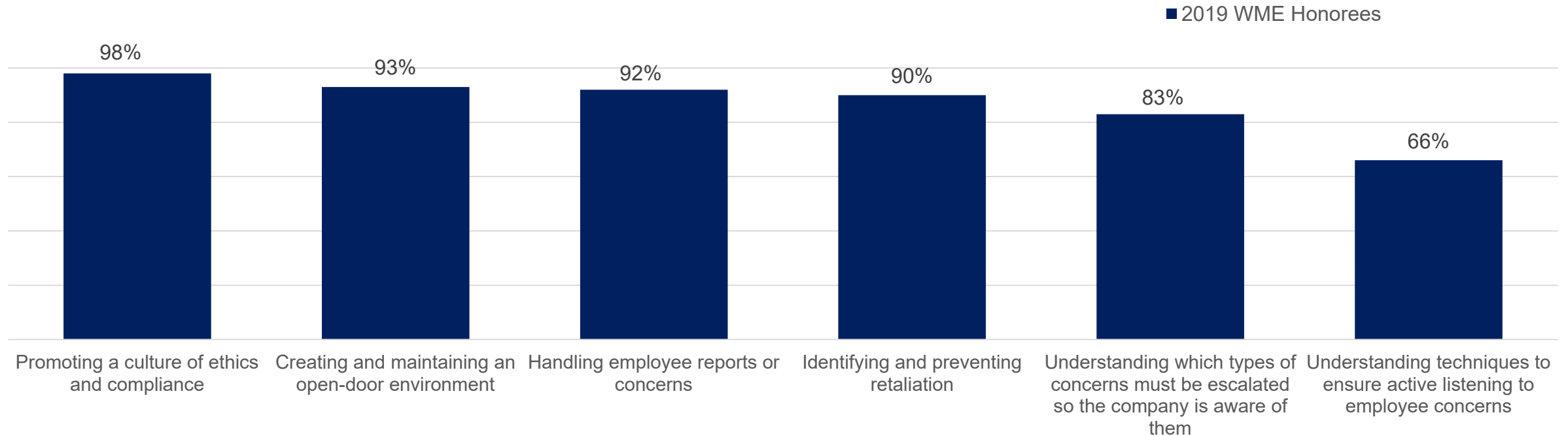
