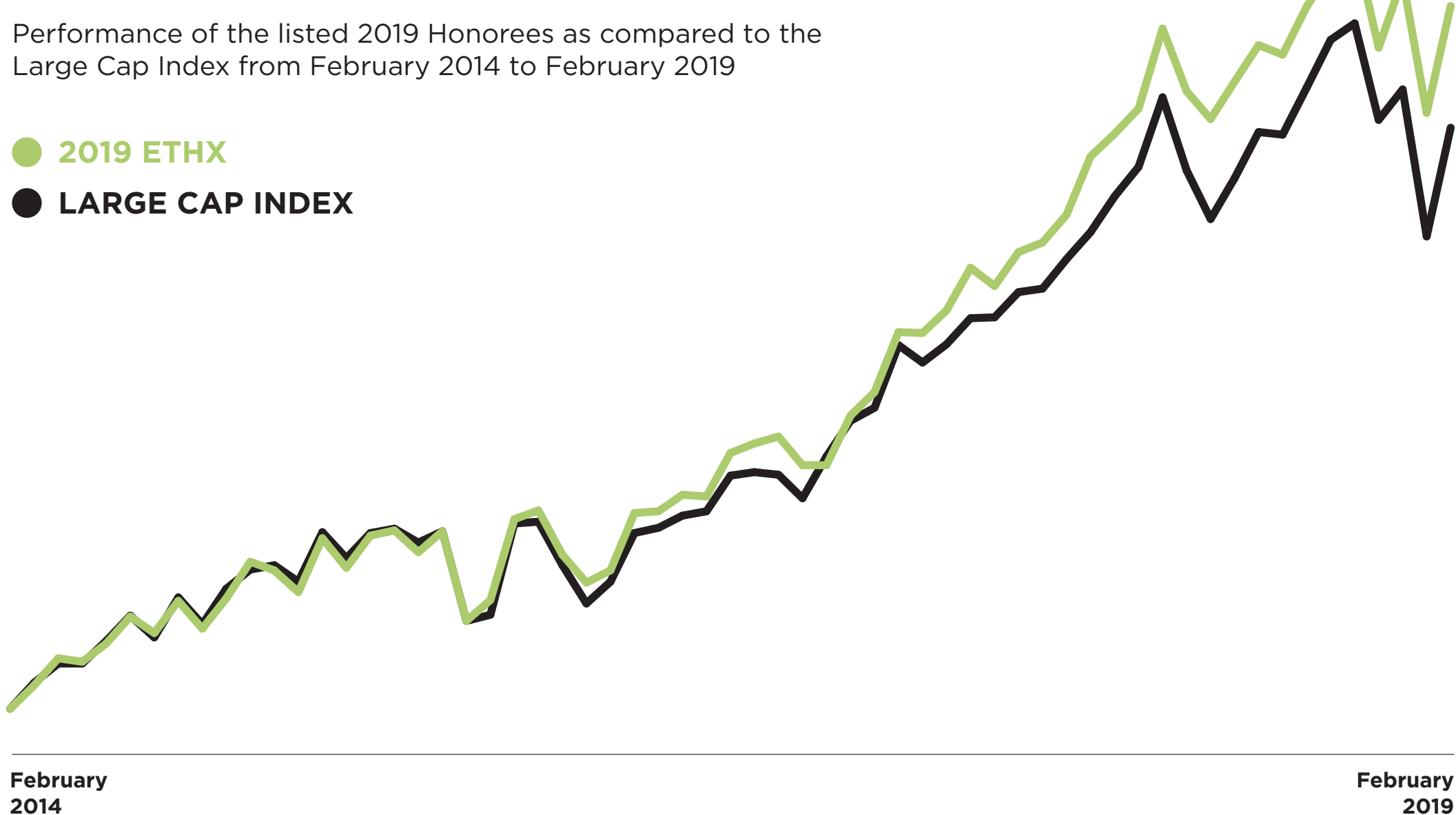

What is Evaluated?

WME Applications evaluate a company's performance using hundreds of inputs organized into five weighted categories.

Ethics and Compliance Program	Application Weight of 35%
Measurement of Ethical Culture	20%
Sustainability & Corporate Social Responsibility	20%
Corporate Governance	15%
Leadership and Reputation	10%

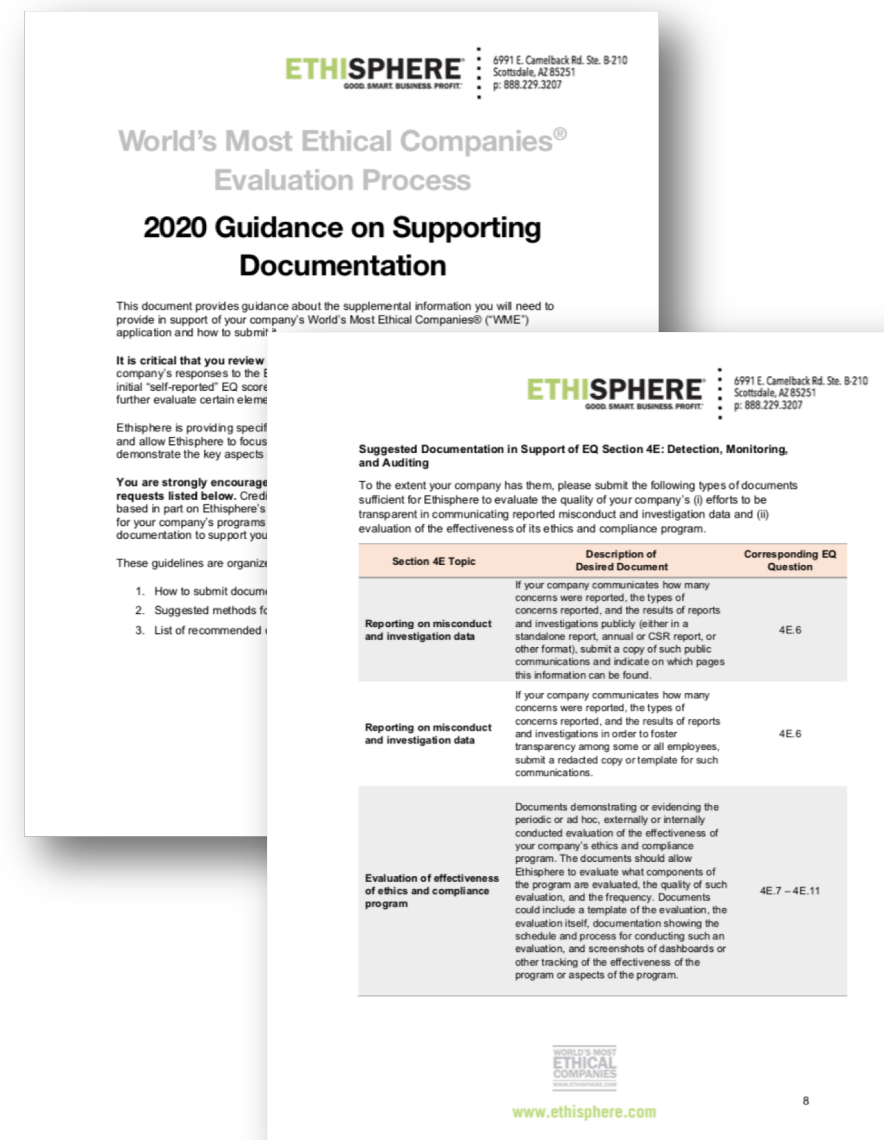

What Documentation is Requested?

- Documentation used to verify select EQ survey answers and attest to the quality of underlying programs and practices
- 33 items requested across 10 categories
- Clear associations between documents and survey questions
- Preferred secure file upload service: Box
- Redact as needed
- Follow the Guidelines closely:
 1. How to submit documents to Ethisphere
 2. Suggested methods for organizing documents
 3. List of recommended documents to submit
- Ask questions!



How Are Companies Evaluated?

- 1 Self-Reported EQ Score automatically generated from questionnaire results
- 2 Documentation reviewed to attest to the quality of program and related elements and qualitatively scored
- 3 Adverse media search and review of outstanding litigation, history of misconduct, overall ethical track record using public sources and Factiva
- 4 EQ survey, documentation, and research combines to arrive at a final EQ score is generated
- 5 Final EQ score is evaluated in the context of like-applicants

What's Changed for 2020?

■ **Ethics Quotient Questionnaire**

- Annotated document for easy identification of year-over-year changes
- Changes focused on clarifying existing questions
- New question on how managers are interacting with the report intake system
- New question evaluating mental health programs for employees

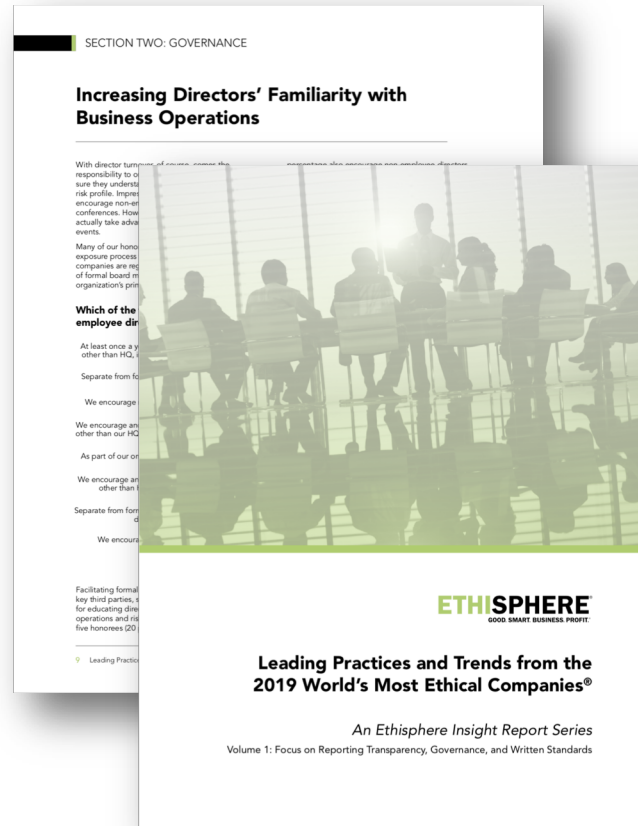
■ **Documentation Requirements**

- Annotated document for easy identification of year-over-year changes
- Changes focused on clarifying existing questions
- Request for how organizations are leveraging the findings following an assessment of their ethical culture

I'm Ready. What Should I Do First?

1. Confirm Organization Eligibility

- Any company, public or private, for-profit or not-for-profit, based anywhere in the world, is eligible to participate
- Non-profit colleges and universities, governments, governmental agencies, government majority owned companies, and NGOs are not eligible

2. Review Application Materials

- Previous honoree? Your application has been sent automatically
- Viewing this live? Link to form will be sent in follow up email
- Listening to a recording? Register at: www.worldsmostethicalcompanies.com

3. Review the FAQs

Avoiding Common Application Pitfalls

- Start early!
- Use PDF version of the Ethics Quotient survey to solicit input and prepare responses in advance of completing the online survey
- Heed the the FAQ section of Ethisphere's WME website
- Designate a single individual to own the survey and application process
- Lean on the documentation guidelines as you organize and prepare your submission
- Request a copy of your previous EQ survey results
- Save a record of your application and materials for future years

What Does it Cost to Apply?

\$3,000 Administrative Fee

- Only required fee to participate
- The same fee regardless of organization
- Unchanged from 2019 application year
